



THE MINUTES OF THE EXTRAORDINARY LYNG PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON WEDNESDAY ^{31st} AUGUST 2022 STARTING AT 7.30PM IN THE VILLAGE HALL.

2. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST & REQUESTS FOR DISPENSATIONS

A personal declaration of interest was received from Cllr Meader as a member of the Bowls Club. He confirmed that he would be taking part in the discussions but would not vote.

3. TO CONSIDER / APPROVE FURTHER ACTION REGARDING BOWLS CLUB VEHICLE ACCESS ON THE PLAYING FIELD IN LIGHT OF RECENT EVENTS AND FOLLOWING RECEIPT OF SOLICITORS LETTER

Following discussion, during which each Councillor was given the opportunity to present their views and both sides of the argument were raised and debated, it was **AGREED** by majority that the Clerk contact NPLAW and take up the subscription offer, with a view to obtaining a final legal and judicial outcome as proposed by Cllr Davies, seconded by Cllr Joyce with one in agreement. Cllr Orton and Cllr Jarvis voted against the proposal and Cllr Meader abstained from the vote. Cllr Orton requested that the minutes record that he opposed the motion as the Council has twice received advice from a solicitor and has ignored that advice. This was also the view of Cllr Jarvis.

It was confirmed that the Bowls Club have the gate code and that the Council's decision regarding Bowls Club vehicular access (made 16th March 2022) still currently stands. (A copy of the correspondence received from the Bowls Club is attached to these minutes)
